






Figure 1. On–Region Characteristics




Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics




Figure 3. On-Resistance versus Drain Current




Figure 4. On-Resistance versus Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Figure 5. On–Resistance Variation with Temperature





Figure 6. Drain-to-Source Leakage Current versus Voltage

Figure 8. Gate-To-Source and Drain-To-Source Voltage versus Total Charge




Figure 9. Resistive Switching Time Variation versus Gate Resistance




Figure 10. Diode Forward Voltage versus Current




Figure 11. Maximum Rated Forward Biased Safe Operating Area







Figure 12. Thermal Response


